Read the passage (John 6:60-71) and answer the following questions:

1. What stands out most and why?
 2. What does the passage reveal to us about God?

 4. What are the immediate application points?
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DEEPER DISCUSSION

1. The disciples (the crowds) struggled with Jesus' words. Why, did they (and do we) struggle with Jesus' words?
2. What in particular did Jesus say that they struggled with?
3. Are there other areas of God's Word with which your friends and family struggle, or find hard to accept? What are those issues?
4. What does it mean that the Spirit gives life?
5. Why is the flesh of "no help at all" in spiritual things/eternal life?
6. What does Jesus mean when He said that His words are spirit and life?
7. What does it mean to feed on Christ –to eat His flesh and drink His blood?
8. Share with your Life Group your experience when you realized that Jesus is the only One who has the words of life. What was that like when "the light bulb turned on" –when the Spirit illuminated this truth to you.
9. Has there been a time in your life when you chose to believe God's Word before figuring everything out? What happened after your chose to believe and then, like Peter, you saw through faith what the Lord was teaching you?
