DEEPER DISCUSSION

1. What is the ministry Paul is talking about in verse 1? What is an Apostle? Although we believe that the "office" of Apostle was a temporary ministry to help establish the church, how can the church be built up and strengthened by those with apostolic (ground-breaking messenger) passions and gifts?
2. Why does Paul say that some people won't receive the Gospel (v.3-4)? What does it mean that their minds have been blinded?
3. What is the remedy for blind minds? How has God chosen to make people see the truth of the Gospel?
4. Who do you know that struggles to understand and to see the truth of Christ? What can you do to help them to know the truth?
5. Why does Paul describe our salvation in terms of light and darkness (v.6)?
