3. What is it about the gospel that is so powerful? How does the message of the gospel differ from modern self-help theories and strategies?
4. On Sunday Pastor Kevin made the statement "If you put really big faith in really big lies, you'll be let down in really big ways." What are some of those lies that we have foolishly trusted in?
5. "We are not saved by the strength of our faith, but by the strength of the object of our faith." How does that statement encourage you or strengthen you? Why is that such an important message for us to remember?
6. The just shall live by faith. Why is that Biblical theme so important to us? What does it mean?
