DEEPER DISCUSSION

3. What are the factors that would make it easier for you to trust God when life seems unfair?
4. On Sunday we mentioned that love is a better motivator than fear or guilt. What did we mean with that statement? How can you nurture a love for the Lord and a "delight" in Him in your own life?
5. We mentioned that committing your way to the Lord requires a sense of surrender with timelines and outcomes. Why do we struggle to surrender those things to God?
6. We are told to be still and wait patiently for the Lord (v.7). Is that something that comes naturally to you? Why or why not? What can you do in order to grow in that area?
